APPLICATION REQUIREMENT

Applicants: Please read the following guidelines carefully, all application requirements must be received by September 1, 2013 as one packet. Late applications or incomplete applications will not be considered.

- Application form- Please fill out the application form in its entirety.
- ➤ Letters of Recommendation- Two (2) letters of recommendations are required. Please do not submit more than (2) letters.
 - One letter should be from a school administrator or a teacher
 - One letter should be from a person that can best asses your intellect, character, and suitability for military service (and not a family member or relative).
- Letters of recommendations should be sealed and included in your application packet.
- ➤ Official Transcripts- Submit copies of official transcripts from all schools attended with school official's signature across the sealed envelope. Include weighted and un-weighted GPA and course information only if pertinent.
- ➤ Standardized Test Results Your scores should be sent directly from the testing services, using SAT code **0236** or ACT code **7191**. If your high school includes your ACT or SAT scores on your official transcript those scores will be accepted. Scores must be received by September 1, 2013.
- Personal Essay- In two pages or less (500 words) write an essay that provides insight into 1) Why you desire to attend a U.S. Service Academy 2) What impact will the experience have on you and on your community (3) Why public service is important to you. Please attach the essay to the application form.
- Resume- Provide a detailed listing of your academic, community service, extracurricular and athletic activities and other notable accomplishments.
- ➤ Pictures Please do not send pictures.
- ➤ Interviews- Interviews will be conducted as part of the nomination process only for the most competitive applicants.
- Must be a Virginia resident to qualify for a nomination from Senator Tim Kaine
- Reminder: You must separately apply to the Service Academy School of your choice.
