A BILL

To place limitations on excepting positions from the competitive service, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Saving the Civil Serv-

5 ice Act".

6 SEC. 2. LIMITATIONS ON EXCEPTING POSITIONS FROM

7 COMPETITIVE SERVICE AND TRANSFERRING
8 POSITIONS.

9 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—

1	(1) the term "agency" means any department,
2	agency, or instrumentality of the Federal Govern-
3	ment;
4	(2) the term "competitive service" has the
5	meaning given the term in section 2102 of title 5,
6	United States Code;
7	(3) the term "Director" means the Director of
8	the Office of Personnel Management; and
9	(4) the term "excepted service" has the mean-
10	ing given the term in section 2103 of title 5, United
11	States Code.
12	(b) LIMITATIONS.—A position in the competitive
13	service may not be excepted from the competitive service
14	unless that position is placed—
15	(1) in any of schedules A through E, as de-
16	scribed in section 6.2 of title 5, Code of Federal
17	Regulations, as in effect on September 30, 2020;
18	and
19	(2) under the terms and conditions under part
20	6 of title 5, Code of Federal Regulations, as in effect
21	on September 30, 2020.
22	(c) TRANSFERS.—
23	(1) WITHIN EXCEPTED SERVICE.—A position in
24	the excepted service may not be transferred to any

1	schedule other than a schedule described in sub-
2	section $(b)(1)$.
3	(2) OPM CONSENT REQUIRED.—An agency
4	may not transfer any occupied position from the
5	competitive service or the excepted service into
6	schedule C of subpart C of part 213 of title 5, Code
7	of Federal Regulations, or any successor regulations,
8	without the prior consent of the Director.
9	(3) Limit during presidential term.—Dur-
10	ing any 4-year presidential term, an agency may not
11	transfer from a position in the competitive service to
12	a position in the excepted service the greater of the
13	following:
14	(A) A total number of employees that is
15	more than 1 percent of the total number of em-
16	ployees employed by that agency, as of the first
17	day of that presidential term.
18	(B) 5 employees.
19	(4) Employee consent required.—Notwith-
20	standing any other provision of this section—
21	(A) an employee who occupies a position in
22	the excepted service may not be transferred to
23	an excepted service schedule other than the
24	schedule in which that position is located with-

1	out the prior written consent of the employee;
2	and
3	(B) an employee who occupies a position in
4	the competitive service may not be transferred
5	to the excepted service without the prior written
6	consent of the employee.
7	(d) Other Matters.—
8	(1) Application.—Notwithstanding section
9	7425(b) of title 38, United States Code, this section
10	shall apply to a position under chapter 73 or 74 of
11	that title.
12	(2) Report.—Not later than March 15 of each
13	calendar year, the Director shall submit to Congress
14	a report on the immediately preceding calendar year
15	that lists—
16	(A) each position that, during the year cov-
17	ered by the report, was transferred from the
18	competitive service to the excepted service and
19	a justification as to why each such position was
20	so transferred; and
21	(B) any violation of this section that oc-
22	curred during the year covered by the report.
23	(e) REGULATIONS.—Not later than 90 days after the
24	date of enactment of this Act, the Director shall issue reg-
25	ulations to implement this section.
